Secretary

Three-year term: November 2026-November 2029

Treasurer

Three-year term: November 2026-November 2029

The Treasurer keeps the President and the Board of Directors informed of the Corporation's financial status and provides reports and financial accountings as requested. The Treasurer also chairs the Finance Committee and carries out such other responsibilities as designated by the Board of Directors.

Director-at-Large

Three (3) - Three-year term: November 2026-November 2029

Two (2) - Two-year term: November 2026-November 2028
